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Mark J. Ashley, Sc.D., is co-founder, president and CEO of Centre for Neuro Skills®, which operates post-acute brain injury rehabilitation programs at facilities in Bakersfield, Calif.; Encino, Calif.; and Irving, Tx. Dr. Ashley has served on the Board of Directors for the Brain Injury Institute of America (BIA) for three years and currently serves as the organization's Chairman of the Board of Directors. He is the immediate past Chair of the Corporate Advisory Committee of the American Academy for Certification of Brain Injury Specialists and also serves as the Liaison for the BIA and the Brain Injury Special Interest Group of the American Congress of Rehabilitation Medicine.

Dr. Ashley has participated in the preparation of Traumatic Brain Injury Medical Treatment Guidelines for the State of Colorado Department of Labor and Employment and also has served on the grant review committee for the Colorado Traumatic Brain Injury Trust Fund. Additionally, Dr. Ashley serves on the board of NASCAR legend Ernie Irvan's Race 2 Safety Foundation, which is dedicated to prevention and awareness of brain injury.

The Centre for Neuro Skills® Clinical Research and Education Foundation, a non-profit research organization, was founded by Dr. Ashley. He is currently an Adjunct Professor for Southern Illinois University's Department of Communications Disorders and Sciences in the College of Education, specializing in brain injury and cognitive deficits. He is also a licensed Speech/Language Pathologist in California and Texas, and is a Certified Case Manager.

Dr. Ashley's work has been published in numerous professional and research publications. Dr. Ashley is also the author of two books: *Working with Behavior Disorders: Strategies for Traumatic Brain Injury Rehabilitation* and *Traumatic Brain Injury Rehabilitation*, now in its second edition.
